


Balloon Tower Competition in French



G7 Showscase (Middle Ages Exhibition)




G9 I&S Public Debate

PARENTS, STUDENTS, TEACHERS. AND OTHERS FROM THE WIDER COMMUNITY WERE INVITED TO SEE 9A TAKE ON 9B, 9C TAKE ON 9D, AND 9E TAKE ON 9F.
