How to Sign up on SchoolsBuddy



Parents can sign up for both activities (Teacher led and External ECPs) on a platform called SchoolsBuddy. This is a software platform for integrating parent communications, after school activities signup and allocation.

The signup requires the parents to make choice of activity and submit these choices through SchoolsBuddy. The School will then allocate based upon your selections and the group size. When the signup period closes, the School will begin the process of allocating students. Parents will receive the email notification of the allocated activities. Your Diary will be automatically populated with the time and date of the events of the clubs/activities allocated for your child.

Please note that once the programs start, the registers on SchoolsBuddy will be checked by our homeroom teachers, serving as consent from parents for students to leave class and attend their respective ECPs. No place is confirmed if the student's name is not listed on SchoolsBuddy's registers.

Please also note that there are limits on how many students can join each activity. When an ECP reaches its maximum capacity (e.g., 20 students), the option to select that ECP may be removed from SchoolsBuddy.

Additional Information:

In Terms 1 and 2, places in the Extra Curricular Programme are allocated on a “First Come, First Served” basis. Each ECP has a maximum number of participants, and once all slots are filled, additional students are placed on a waiting list. If a student withdraws from an ECP, the first student on the waiting list is added.

In Term 3, preference is given to students who did not receive their chosen ECP allocations in Terms 1 or 2. Priority is given to students who have not participated in the activity during the previous term.
