"All About Bullying" presentation

During Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th, we held a presentation for parents around 'All about bullying'. This was an informative workshop aimed at providing parents with further information around what bullying may look like and some of the root causes and effects of bullying. Some of the topics covered were:

- · Definition of bullying and where it may take place
- Why children may bully, which includes a person being 'different' due to disabilities, race, situations at home etc.
- Signs to look out for if your child may be bullied.
- The importance of us as parents to model respectful and tolerant behaviours for our children.
- Questions to ask and reasons for why your child may be bullying others, along with conversation starters.
- Our values and the preventative measures we adopt at Raha to foster an inclusive environment.

For those that attended the presentation, we hope you found it informative and useful. For those that were unable to attend, please feel free to contact us.

We have attached a <u>link to my presentation</u>, along with some activities and conversation starters you can do with your child/ren. This also includes a short film and a 5-minute mediation video. I implore you to watch this video which highlights the importance of simply being kind and the positive impact it can have of just being 'heard'.

As for the meditation video, I would encourage you to do this with your child prior to starting any discussion around bullying, which can be divisive and evoke many feelings.
