#### Emirati Genome Program Q&A

Fatima Al Hosani is a Grade 10 Student undertaking her personal project.

"I am enthusiastic about developing and enhancing the UAE's medical industry's future. It's possible that you have negative perceptions about the Emirati Genome program or have never heard of it before, so I went a step up to inform the Raha community."

The program is a nationwide initiative to use genomic data to enhance the health of the Emirati people. To help with the prevention and treatment of chronic diseases, the initiative entails scientific study and research targeted at profiling and determining gene sequencing among UAE nationals.

"From my studies, I recognize there is some misinformation circulating about the program, and I have arranged for the Director of the program to speak and answer questions at our school."
