ADEK requires all schools to administer an annual attainment test in Mathematics, English, and Science and the *GL Education Primary Progress Tests* are the ones Raha uses. The information gathered from these assessments helps the school identify trends in achievement across grade levels and subject areas. While individual results are also examined, they form only part of our full and holistic understanding of students' learning.
